On 1 October 2018, the [Heavy Vehicle National Law \(HVNL\)](#) was amended to provide that every party in the heavy vehicle transport supply chain has a duty to ensure the safety of their transport activities. OSHA Updates National Emphasis Program on Trenching and Excavation

OSHA has updated its National Emphasis Program (NEP) on preventing trenching and excavation collapses in response to a recent spike in trenching fatalities. Under the NEP, OSHA will increase its education and enforcement efforts; inspectors will record trenching and excavation inspections in a national reporting system; and each area office will develop outreach programs. - Safety can also refer to the control of recognized hazards in order to achieve an acceptable level of risk.

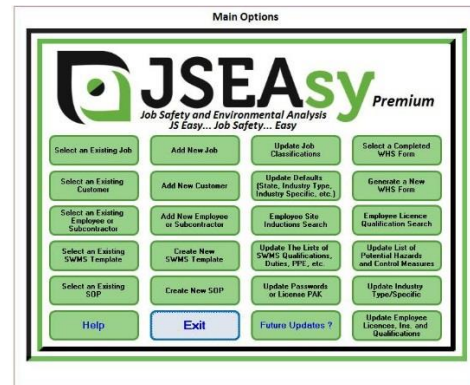
